

# Getabout Access Scheme









### What is Getabout?

An access scheme for people who have difficulty getting around Northumberland, funded by Northumberland County Council.

#### Two parts:

- Community Development carried out by Community Action Northumberland & Northumberland County Council
- Service delivered by Adapt (North East)

This presentation focuses on the service delivery.









#### **Service Aims**

- To ensure people in need of support with transport are able to access existing services.
- To address gaps in service to enable people to make essential journeys eg to attend health appointments.
- To gather information about type and level of unmet need.









#### Who can use Getabout?

People who have no public transport available to them and:

- do not drive, either because they are too young, have never driven or are no longer able to; or
- have no access or limited access to a car as it is not affordable or not there during the day; or
- have a mobility difficulty which prevents them from using public transport.









## **Getabout Telephone Helpline**

Callers can speak to experienced advisors who help them to find the most appropriate way of solving their transport problems Solutions could include:

- Information about existing public transport services, taxi
  operators etc for those able to make their own way.
- Signposting those with higher levels of need to more specialist services eg community transport, shared affordable taxi services, local lift shares etc.









## **Partnership Working**

Essential - Partners provide us with information, help promote Getabout, accept referrals and work with us to address gaps in service.

- County Council Public & Community Transport & Taxi Licensing
- Health PALS, (Patient Advice and Liaison Service)
- larger Community Transport Providers eg NEED, Red Cross, WATbus
- Services for specific user groups eg Age UK, Northumberland County Blind Association
- Local community schemes: eg Bell View, Upper Coquetdale Community Transport, Upper Coquetdale Churches Together









#### **Getabout Volunteer Drivers**

Where no existing service is available to enable a caller to undertake an essential journey, Getabout may be able to provide a volunteer driver who:

- Uses their own cars to offer a lift
- Has undergone appropriate checks eg DBS, current licence, appropriate insurance
- Been given appropriate training.









#### What we have achieved so far

Since April 2016, we have received 123 enquiries:

- 76 people were signposted to service providers including: Community Transport operators, Other Car schemes, Public transport, Taxi services, NEAS, Own solution.
- 20 people were supported to become eligible for Patient Transport.
- 27 people were provided transport by Getabout.
