

Older people

- Poverty/low income comparable with urban areas
- Poor mobility getting worse
- Poor health not reflected in healthcare funding
- Unmet care needs not reflected in funding
- Local services closing getting worse
- Few social and family contacts
- Crime/fear of crime under reporting



Table discussions



To identify actions which should be taken both generally and by CAN, to reduce rural deprivation and to suggest what can be done by/for those affected by rural deprivation.
