Bridge Northumberland is here to help you take control and change your life by:

- Providing one to one support
- Helping you with skills and training
- Finding opportunities to unlock your potential
- Boosting your confidence and future prospects

What we do

We do this by giving you one to one support from a dedicated Bridge worker who'll be with you every step of the way to improving your confidence and developing your skills.

Our support is **free**. The programme is **completely voluntary** and for anyone who is:

- Aged 16 years not in education or training
- 18 to 65 and unemployed
- Lives in Northumberland

How we work with you

Your Bridge worker will work with you to create personalised unique support package depending on your needs, taking realistic, manageable steps towards your development. We'll help you to build on your strengths and goals, using the skills and expertise of our charity partners.

Our support includes:

- one-to-one contact (by phone or meetings)
- support to get into training and education
- access to volunteering opportunities
- coaching and counselling to help your mental wellbeing
- advice on money and debt management
- digital skills training
- support with job searching, application forms, CV writing and job interview skills

Who we are

We are funded by The National Lottery Community Fund and The European Social Fund. Northumberland County Council is our lead partner.

Our free service is delivered by our expert charity partners across Northumberland. The Bridge Northumberland partnership has lots of experience and knowledge in supporting people.

Since 2018 we've successfully supported over 1,000 Northumberland residents to get a positive outcome.
