The buses where I live have been getting worse and worse each year, with more and more cuts. It makes it hard for young people like myself to find a job when we live in a rural area and cannot afford to run a car. It is just not fair." (Delilah, bus user)

Elderly people who no longer have a car really depend on bus services to maintain their independence. If villages are cut off, as is happening, elderly people will be more and more isolated." (John, bus user)



#### State of Rural Services Report (2017)

- Declining public & private services
- Local buses and bank branches
- 49% of households in villages have access to a regular bus service
- Affects access to a whole range of other services
- Online service growth
- 50% rural users cannot get to FE college by public transport or walking in a 'reasonable travel time'
- Public health funding £30 per head (rural), £51 per head (urban)
