About Northumberland Rural Employment Hubs

Community Action Northumberland runs the Rural Employment Hubs project to support unemployed residents in rural areas of Northumberland. We help people to overcome the multiple barriers they face when looking to move into employment.

The project recognises people in rural areas face additional difficulties when searching for work compared to those in urban areas, including fewer local employment/volunteering/training opportunities, higher travel costs both to sign on and to attend interviews, and poor internet connections making online job searches more difficult.
